TITLE: PUBLIC SAFETY RADIO TECHNICIAN (Provisional Appointment*)

SALARY: \$33,272 - \$42,801 annually

LOCATION: Monroe County Department of Public Safety

JOB SUMMARY: This is a technical position responsible for the operation, maintenance and repair of public safety electronic and two-way radio equipment. The employee reports directly to, and works under the general supervision of, the Public Safety Communications Administrator and the Senior Public Safety Radio Technician in accordance with laws and regulations prescribed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). Employees will be required to obtain a Class *B* Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with no Air Brake restriction during the probationary period, with the employing agency providing sufficient training, road time, and vehicle to obtain the license. Employees who do not successfully obtain a Class *B* CDL with no Air Brake restriction (L2 on driver's license designates there is an Air Brake restriction) during the probationary period will be removed from the position. Does related work as required.

PROPOSED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma, plus one (1) year of paid full-time or its part-time equivalent experience in the maintenance and repair of two-way radio equipment.

NOTE: College level training cannot be used as a substitute for work experience.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Depending on position duties, candidates for employment with Monroe County Government will be required to pass a pre-employment drug test and physical. Applicants may be required to undergo a state and national criminal history background investigation, which will include a fingerprint check, to determine suitability for appointment. Failure to meet the standards for the background investigation may result in disqualification.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT: Applicant must be a resident of Monroe County at the time of appointment and for at least four (4) months at the time of examination.
