TITLE: SENIOR PUBLIC HEALTH ENGINEER (Provisional* Appointment)

SALARY: \$62,152 - \$80,002 annually

LOCATION: Monroe County Department of Public Health

JOB SUMMARY:

This is a professional public health engineering position involving responsibility for: furnishing advice and guidance to local officials and the general public in regard to environmental health problems and the measures necessary for improvements and compliance with legal requirements; providing leadership in promotion of public health through application of environmental health practices; enforcement of the provisions of the Public Health Laws and Sanitary Codes in relation to environmental health matters. This position differs from the lower level Assistant Public Health Engineer by virtue of its responsibility for program planning and development. Employees may be responsible for one or more specialized areas of environmental health. Supervision is exercised over a professional environmental health staff. Work is conducted under general supervision from an Associate or Principal Public Health Engineer. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Engineering, plus; EITHER:

- (A) Two (2) years of paid full-time or its part-time equivalent experience in the implementation of environmental health programs, or as an environmental health engineer; OR;
- (B) Three (3) years of paid full-time or its part-time equivalent experience in environmental health engineering, one (1) year of which shall have been with a health agency in a position responsible for implementing public health programs; OR;
- (C) Any equivalent combination of education and experience as defined by the limits of (A) and (B) above.

NOTE:

A Master's degree in Engineering may be honored in lieu of one (1) year of required general experience.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Possession of a license to practice engineering in New York State at time of appointment.

Candidates for employment with Monroe County Government will be required to pass a pre-employment drug test, along with a background investigation. Failure to meet the standards may result in disqualification.

If you are appointed, you will be required to possess a valid license to operate a motor vehicle in New York State or otherwise demonstrate your capacity to meet the transportation needs of the position.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT:

Applicant must be a resident of Monroe County at the time of appointment and for at least four (4) months at the time of examination.
