**TITLE:** MAINTENANCE MECHANIC I (Golf Course Mechanic)

**SALARY:** \$31,421 - \$40,466 annually

**LOCATION:** Monroe County Golf Courses

### **JOB SUMMARY:**

This is a skilled position involving responsibility for efficient and workmanlike performance of a variety of building, installing, maintaining and repairing tasks requiring a good knowledge of one or more of the electrical, mechanical or construction trades, such as carpentry, plumbing, painting, electrical repair, welding, sheet metal work, auto mechanics, masonry, golf course maintenance and related trades. This title differs from Maintenance Mechanic II in the greater responsibility for proper implementation and completion of large projects, requiring the coordination of many activities or trade skills. The work is reviewed by supervisors either by checking completed work, conducting periodic spot checks, or reviewing submitted reports. This position reports directly to, and works under the general supervision of a foreman or other higher level staff member, but independent judgment is exercised in choosing methods or procedures. General supervision may be exercised over other lower level employees. Does related work as required.

### **PREFERRED EXPERIENCE:**

Recent experience and current abilities in golf course equipment maintenance and repair, including reel and bed knife grinding, establishing a quality cut for reel mowers, working knowledge of golf course equipment hydraulic and electrical systems, mower back-lapping, mower set-up, calibration of equipment, irrigation system maintenance, top-dresser and aerification equipment operations, height/frequency of cut adjustments, and diagnose after cut appearance.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma, plus three (3) years of paid full-time or its part-time equivalent experience as a skilled worker in one (1) or more of the electrical, mechanical, or construction trades.

### **NOTE:**

Additional experience may be substituted for the high school diploma on a year-for-year basis.

### **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Candidates for employment with Monroe County Government will be required to pass a pre-employment drug test, along with a background investigation. Failure to meet the standards may result in disqualification.

If you are appointed, you will be required to possess a valid license to operate a motor vehicle in New York State or otherwise demonstrate your capacity to meet the transportation needs of the position.

### **RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT:**

Applicant must be a resident of Monroe County at the time of appointment.
