## **JOB SUMMARY:**

This is a skilled trade position responsible for performing a variety of plumbing and steamfitting tasks, routine maintenance, and odd jobs. Work may be conducted during nights and weekends. Work is performed in accordance with applicable health and safety standards such as the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). The employee reports directly to and works under the general supervision of a higher level staff member, with leeway allowed for planning the details of assignments. Lead supervision may be exercised over the work of a plumber's helper or laborers. Does related work as required.

#### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma, plus two (2) years paid full-time or its parttime equivalent plumbing experience at the journeyman level.

#### **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Possession of a current Plumbing License issued by the City of Rochester.

Welding, Valve Maintenance and Repair, and Silver Braising and Soldering certifications are required at time of appointment.

Candidates for employment with Monroe County Government will be required to pass a pre-employment drug test, along with a background investigation. Failure to meet the standards may result in disqualification.

If you are appointed, you will be required to possess a valid license to operate a motor vehicle in New York State or otherwise demonstrate your capacity to meet the transportation needs of the position.

# **RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT:**

Applicant must be a resident of Monroe County at the time of appointment.
