- (B) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with an Associate's degree in Civil, Chemical, or Environmental Engineering or a closely related field, or one of the natural or physical sciences, plus three (3) years paid full-time or its part-time equivalent experience as defined in (A) above; OR,
- (C) Five (5) years paid full-time or its part-time equivalent experience as defined in (A) above; OR,
- (D) An equivalent combination of education and experience as defined by the limits of (A), (B) and (C) above.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:
