DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is a skilled electrical position involving the installation, maintenance and repair of electrical equipment, and equipment associated with sanitary sewage lift stations. Equipment includes but is not limited to motors; motor starters; control circuits; relays; electronic pressure switches; transformers; lighting and wiring. Employee reports to and works under the general supervision of higher level staff member. Supervision of others is not a responsibility of this class. Employees are on call 24 hours in case of emergency. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES (All need not be performed in a given position. Other related activities may be performed although not listed):

Maintains and repairs mechanical pumping systems found in sanitary sewage lift stations including shafts, seals, bearings, impellers and valves;

Maintains, repairs and monitors sewer video inspection equipment;

Maintains and repairs vehicles, motorized equipment and tools;

Assists in preparation of maintenance schedules and budgets:

Interprets electrical codes and properly plans and installs electrical equipment to NEC standards;

Requisitions parts and supplies needed for system or vehicle maintenance or repairs;

Coordinates street lighting efforts.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL

CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of 3-Phase electrical distribution equipment, motors, starters, relays and single phase control circuits as well as the electromechanical systems commonly found in sewage lift stations; working knowledge of all types of 3-Phase circuits and single phase street lighting circuits; working knowledge of street light design as well as codes and policies of the Rochester Gas & Electric street lighting department; maintenance, diagnosis and repair skills. Willing to work in adverse weather conditions; ability to work independently; manual dexterity; good judgment; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma; PLUS five (5) years of paid full-time or its part-time equivalent experience servicing 3-Phase electrical equipment and single phase control circuits, which shall have involved maintaining and servicing sewage lift stations and associated systems.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Depending on the position duties, candidates for employment with Monroe County Government will be required to pass a pre-employment drug test.

3-Phase Electricians License and New York State Commercial Drivers License with tank endorsement at time of appointment.

If you are appointed, you will be required to have a valid license to operate a motor vehicle in New York State or otherwise demonstrate your capacity to meet the transportation needs of the job.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND BOCES

Per Chapter 180 of the Laws of 2000, and by Regulations of the Commissioner of Education, to be employed in a position designated by a school district or BOCES as involving direct contact with students, a clearance for employment from the State Education Department is required.
