DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is an entry level position involving assisting in a variety of painting and refinishing tasks. Work is performed under the direct supervision of a Painter or other supervisory personnel. (May be required to work other than day-time hours.) Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Prepares surfaces by scraping, brushing, or burning off old finishes;

Paints all types of furniture, equipment and interior walls;

Refinishes desks, tables, furniture floors and trim;

Cleans brushes and equipment;

May do minor exterior painting;

May incidentally perform routine work in connection with the trade.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Working knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology, and accident precautions of the trade; ability to follow directions.
