## **FACILITIES MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR**

Code No. 5-06-003 Competitive

**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:** Directs the work of repair foremen assigned to building, mechanical, and grounds upkeep tasks and schedules and coordinates both jobs and manpower with which he is charged; does related work as required.

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This is a management level job in a school district involving responsibility for the general maintenance, repair, and upkeep of buildings and grounds. The employee works under the direction of the Director of Buildings and Grounds.

## **EXAMPLES OF DUTIES**: (Illustrative only)

Confers with Director regarding requested or necessary repair and alteration work;

Assigns foremen and crews to specific maintenance jobs;

Confers with foreman regarding scope and nature of assigned tasks;

Plots advance assignments for section foremen;

Maintains records and inventory of tools, parts, and equipment;

Keeps records of work performed;

Reviews plans and drawings with superiors and subordinates to determine nature of work;

Submits reports to Director regarding work completed and in progress;

Instructs foremen in methods of work;

Assigns crews to emergency tasks.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES: Good knowledge of school building repair, upkeep, and alteration; good knowledge of grounds and roads maintenance; good knowledge of the building and mechanical trades, such as carpentry, plumbing, masonry, heating, and electrical work; some knowledge of building construction; working knowledge of the operation of building utilities, such as heating, ventilating, and air conditioning; working knowledge of state and association codes; ability to read plans, drawings, and blueprints; ability to organize work and assign crews; supervisory ability; ability to train subordinates; ability to inspect and evaluate completed work; ability to write reports and keep accurate records; ability to work with outside engineers and contractors and to review work in progress; ability to coordinate the work crews under his direction; initiative; reliability; good judgment; good physical condition.

**ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:** Graduation from a standard high school course plus five years experience in the grounds, building or mechanical trades, at least two years of which shall have been in a responsible supervisory capacity; or any equivalent combination of training and experience sufficient to indicate ability to do the work.
