<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This is an entry-level engineering supervisory position involving responsibility for the design and construction of public water supply facilities. Works under the direct supervision of the Civil Engineer when assigned to a specific project and the general supervision of the Senior Civil Engineer. Supervises Technicians as required. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Designs, under the direction of the Civil Engineer, facilities such as pumping stations, structures, water mains and related projects;

Acts as Party Chief of a survey team; reduces survey calculations;

Inspects and resolves contruction problems on projects contracted by the Monroe County Water Authority;

Checks cathodic protection systems and prepares reports;

Conducts soil tests and interprets data for pipeline design;

Makes hydraulic calculations concerning system operations;

Conducts flow tests:

Reviews developers' plans;

Assists in hydraulic network analyses;

Inspects developers' water facilities related construction;

Completes "As Built Drawings";

Makes drawings for pending construction projects;

May obtain easements for construction projects.

CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of Civil Engineering practices as

related to design and construction of public water distribution

facilities; Good knowledge of engineering field survey work; Good

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with an Associate's degree in Sanitary or Civil Engineering plus three (3) years paid full time experience in Sanitary or Civil Design and/or construction.

PROMOTIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

At least two (2) years experience as an Engineering Technician, Construction Inspector or Environmental Technician in the Monroe County Water Authority Engineering and Distribution Department.

<u>SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS</u>: Depending on position duties, candidates for employment with Monroe County Government will be required to pass a pre-employment drug test.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND BOCES
